The text contains the vision of architects, engineers, managers and experts, providing a complete view from social geography and urban planning. The technical knowledge is intertwined with the experiences and stories of the community: athletes and citizens cohabiting these spaces.

The way in which sports and recreational public scenarios are built, adapted and managed in Medellin constitutes a model in the conception of new ways of urban public infrastructure in the city. It also ensures access for everyone with equal opportunities and conditions, this is a strategy transforming the city and it serves as an example applicable in other territories.
