- **Brief Background and Overall Objective:** *In 2013, Ondo State and UN-Habitat signed an agreement to implement programmes aimed at supporting the State in promoting sustainable development in all sectors of the urban economy. The overall objective is of the side event is to share with participants, the progress report on the ongoing partnership programme with the UN-Habitat.*
- **Relevant Focus Areas:** *Local Economic Development (to promote the public, private, academic and civil society sectors to establish partnerships and collaboratively find local solutions to common economic development challenges), Urban Renewal Programme (to create livelihood and economic opportunities and municipal revenue and value sharing possibilities by improving existing urban areas using innovative investment, land use and spatial planning tools), Urban Observatory (to address the urgent need to improve the state-wide base of urban knowledge by supporting society to develop and apply policy-oriented urban indicators, statistics and other urban information), Youth Economic Development (to develop programmes that include establishment of one stop youth/entrepreneurship and skills acquisition centres, a youth development fund, and a youth academy centre for the training and development of the youth in the area of political and business leadership skills), and Public Spaces Development (to address social inclusion, improve integration, mobility and connectivity and better basic service delivery).*

Summary of the Discussion (max: total 500 words):

1. Outline of the discussion/debates:

a) Keynote Address by Dr Bade Omoloja:

- The Governor of the State, Dr. Olusegun Mimiko has shown tremendous interest and demonstrated great passion for issues of urban development and the need to reposition the towns and cities in the state to ensure that they contribute to social and economic development. His achievements include:
 - Massive road construction and upgrading of existing ones to improve connectivity and urban mobility;
 - Development of neighbourhood and regional/international markets to strategically re-organize the way we do business and empower the people under the Wealth Creation and Empowerment scheme;
 - Construction of a one-stop, purpose built International Auto-Mart and Mechanic village to boost local businesses and properly position the state in the sale of motor vehicles in the south west region of Nigeria.
 - Construction of mega schools and provision of free shuttle buses for school children. This is one strategy adopted by the state to bridge the poverty divide and promote equity and inclusiveness.
 - Strategically re-organising the health care delivery system under the 'Abiye' Safe Motherhood Programme to promote equal access to health facilities.
- Dr Boladale Adebawale: Presented a report on the Youth Economic Development Programme component of the UN-Habitat collaboration programme in Ondo State in which she stated that the State's Urban Youth Report for two cities (Akure and Ondo) have already been prepared.
- Prof Banji Oyelaran-Oyelakin: Gave a rundown of the different components of the partnership programme with Ondo State highlighting the various milestones already recorded as well as the goals in sight.
- Feedback Session: There were words of commendation for the State Government from the participants, however, participants observed that the State did not have master plans for its cities and encouraged the State to prepare plans that outline the overall vision of Government for the cities.
